



## **SUMMARY OF THE COUNCIL MEETING OF MARCH 10, 2026 Municipality of Grenville-sur-la-Rouge**

Here are the main resolutions adopted by the council during this meeting.

### **FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION**

- Adoption of a new policy governing the receipt, review, and handling of complaints and concerns from citizens and municipal service users, to ensure consistent, transparent, and thorough management.

### **HUMAN RESOURCES**

- Appointment of the Director of Finance and Assistant general manager as the Municipality's official representative to various organizations (CRA, Revenu Québec, Hydro-Québec, Desjardins, etc.).
- Update on the authorized users of the Desjardins Employer Solution application. The authorized users are now: François Rioux, Serge Raymond, and Tania Marcotte.
- Awarding of a contract to EVOCrh for training on civility and harassment prevention for municipal employees, in the amount of \$1,650.
- Authorization for the Coordinator of Recreation, Culture, Communications, and Community Life to attend the annual conference of the Association des communicateurs municipaux du Québec (ACMQ) in Montreal.

### **PUBLIC WORKS**

- Awarded a contract for plans, specifications, and supervision to Équipe Laurence (\$71,100) for the rehabilitation of Harrington Road – Dobbie sector
- Awarded a contract for the design of plans and specifications to Parallèle 54 for the rehabilitation of Kilmar Road (\$22,300).
- Award of a contract to Enviroc for the geotechnical study and soil characterization on Rivière-Rouge Road (\$31,450).

### **PUBLIC SAFETY**

- Purchase of a 2026 Chevrolet Tahoe for the Fire Department at a cost of \$81,292.91
- Submission of the 2025 annual risk coverage plan report to the Department of Public Safety by the Fire Department director.

### **URBAN PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT**

- The council accepted Ms. Louise Gorman's resignation from the Urban Planning Advisory Committee and recognized her dedication.
- The terms of Nathalie Pedicelli, Gilbert Landry, and André Côté on the Urban Planning Advisory Committee were renewed for two years. Elected officials Patrice Deslongchamps and Carl Woodbury were appointed to the committee.

- Nathalia Czarnecka, Denis Fillion, and Daniel Gauthier are appointed to the Demolition Committee. Carl Woodbury and Manon Jutras are appointed alternate members. Claudy St Onge is appointed designated official.
- The PIIA application regarding the construction of a single-family home on Rue du Lac Wilson is approved and complies with PIIA criteria and CCU recommendations.
- The municipality approves the minor exemption request for reduced side setbacks at 1333 Route 148.
- Submission of a general financial assistance application for the restoration of the Calumet heritage train station.
- The municipality is requesting additional funding from the Ministry of Culture and Communications, through the Heritage Agreements Program, as the current allocation is deemed insufficient to restore the Calumet train station.
- The municipality supports the Space Requirements Planning Project for the Rivière-du-Nord School Service Center and recognizes the need for a new high school in the Argenteuil RCM.

### **LEISURE, COMMUNITY LIFE AND COMMUNICATION**

- The municipality is renewing the \$50-per-week-per-child subsidy for day camps offered to permanent residents of the municipality. Parents applying for the subsidy must be current on their property taxes to be eligible.
- A grant of \$400 is awarded to the Campbell Community Centre for International Women's Day activities.
- The municipality is providing \$1,000 to support the intercultural mediation activities of the Regional Immigration Centre.
- A donation of \$250 is granted for the Argenteuil Hospital Foundation's benefit dinner.
- Elected officials wishing to attend the dinner and show celebrating the 150th anniversary of the village of Grenville will have their expenses reimbursed.

- Adoption of Amendment Bylaw 2026 01 902 amending the zoning bylaw regarding additions and clarifications to definitions related to primary residences, the regulation of tourist rentals, and the addition of a new zone.

- A \$155 financial grant was awarded to two athletes representing the municipality at the 2026 Quebec Games: Félié Allard in curling and Alexis Pilon Castonguay in weightlifting.
