PUBLIC NOTICE

ADOPTION OF BY-LAW NUMBER 2026-04-189 CONCERNING THE REMUNERATION OF ELECTED MUNICIPAL OFFICIALS

Public notice is hereby given that the municipal council will adopt by-law number 2026-04-189 concerning the remuneration of elected municipal officials and committee members at the regular council meeting of May 12, 2026, at 7:00 p.m. at the usual meeting place, namely 88, rue des Érables, Grenville-sur-la-Rouge.

By-law 2026-04-189 will repeal and replace by-law RA-189-06-2018 and provides for:

Base salary is indexed upwards each fiscal year by the amount applicable for the previous fiscal year plus a percentage corresponding to the change in the average Consumer Price Index for the previous year, based on the index established for all of Quebec by Statistics Canada, as published by the Ministry of Municipal Affairs in the Gazette officielle du Québec.


An elected official is entitled to an additional \$50 for attending a meeting of a committee or commission established by council and of which they are a member.

If the deputy mayor replaces the mayor, the deputy mayor will be entitled, starting on the tenth day of their replacement, to an amount equal to the mayor's remuneration. If the position of mayor becomes vacant, the deputy mayor will receive, from the date of the vacancy, an amount equal to the mayor's remuneration until the election.

This by-law contains a clause with retroactive effect to January 1, 2026.

Notice is also given that the draft regulation is available for consultation at the Town Hall located at 88, rue des Érables, Grenville-sur-la-Rouge, during regular opening hours, namely Monday to Thursday from 8:30 a.m. to 12 p.m. and from 1 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. and Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 1 p.m.
