

SUMMARY OF THE COUNCIL MEETING OF APRIL 14, 2026

Municipality of Grenville-sur-la-Rouge

The summary below has no legal value. In the event of any contradiction between this information and the current minutes, the latter shall prevail.

Here are the main resolutions adopted by the board during this meeting.

GENERAL ADMINISTRATION AND REGISTRY

- Adoption of a new policy governing cannabis, alcohol, drugs, medications, and similar substances in the workplace to ensure the health, safety, and well-being of employees and the public.
- Acceptance of the free donation of Lot 6 209 933 for the benefit of the Municipality.
- Authorization of the sale of municipal lot 6 095 015 for \$13,000, corresponding to its market value.
- Approval of a settlement agreement ending a dispute before the Superior Court.
- Official request to the Government of Quebec to amend the TECQ 2024–2028 guidelines to remove the requirement for a minimum thickness of 30 cm for granular resurfacing of local roads.
- The Municipality joined the Union des municipalités du Québec’s insurance consortium to protect the reputation of elected officials and cover criminal liability related to health and safety.
- Participation in an intermunicipal project with the Argenteuil RCM to establish a construction site inspection division, including a request for financial assistance from the Regions and Rural Areas Fund.
- Agreement in principle for a feasibility study on the potential acquisition of the Bell Falls Dam, in collaboration with the MRC and the Fédération québécoise des municipalités.
- Submission of the follow-up report on the recommendations of the Commission municipale du Québec regarding spending authority.
- Membership in FADOQ as an associate municipal member.

HUMAN RESSOURCES

- Acceptance of a blue-collar employee’s resignation.

PUBLIC WORKS AND TECHNICAL SERVICES

- Award of a contract for the supply and application of dust suppressant for the 2026 season to MultiRoutes, in the amount of \$136,000 plus taxes.
- Award of contracts for surveying work on Kilmar and Rivière-Rouge roads to Groupe Barbe & Robidoux SAT Inc. for \$18,000 plus taxes.
- Award of a contract to Groupe Tanguay for the development of a master plan for the water supply network and a hydraulic balance study, for an amount of \$9,000 plus taxes.

- Awarding of contracts for the supply and delivery of granular materials for summer road maintenance to Uniroc (\$25,000 plus tax) and Asphalte et Pavage RF (\$25,000 plus tax).
- Award of an amended contract for a geotechnical study and soil characterization on Chemin Rivière-Rouge to Enviroc, for an amount of \$23,000 plus taxes.

PUBLIC SAFETY

- Authorization to purchase firefighting uniforms for the Fire Department from L'Arsenal, in the amount of \$7,557 plus tax.
- Authorization to sell a surplus vehicle from the Fire Department through the Quebec Government Procurement Center.

LEISURE, COMMUNITY LIFE AND COMMUNICATION

- Proclamation of May 17 as the International Day Against Homophobia and Transphobia in support of the Fondation Émergence.

BY-LAWS

- Adoption of the bylaw on ethics and professional conduct for municipal elected officials.
- Adoption of the RénoFaçade economic development bylaw.
- Adoption of the bylaw concerning safety, peace, and public order.
- Adoption of the bylaw governing the use of the ecocenter's services.
- Notice of motion and adoption of draft bylaws related to the compensation of elected officials, the publication of public notices, and amendments to the urban plan.

CORRESPONDENCE AND NEW BUSINESS

- Support for the opposition to the announced cuts to the Canada Summer Jobs program.
- Support for a request to the Ministère de l'Environnement, des Changements climatiques, de la Forêt et des Parcs to postpone logging operations in areas designated for protected areas in the Laurentians region.
- Granting of \$6,102 in financial assistance to the newly formed organization La Clé d'Argenteuil, which works in the areas of social and community development and housing.
- Granting of \$1,000 in financial assistance to the Notre-Dame-du-Sacré-Cœur Parish.
