

SUMMARY OF THE COUNCIL MEETING OF MAY 13, 2026

Municipality of Grenville-sur-la-Rouge

FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION

Storage of Municipal Archives

The council authorized the signing of an agreement with Revenu Québec for the storage of municipal archives, which was deemed more cost-effective than the previous arrangement.

Maintenance of Private Roads – Domaine Pointe-au-Chêne

Maintenance contracts for the Domaine Pointe-au-Chêne road were authorized with two contractors:

Jason Arnold (snow removal)

- Winter 2026–2027: \$42,684.85 + taxes
- Winter 2027–2028: \$43,756.70 + taxes
- Winter 2028–2029: \$44,853.77 + taxes

Fillion Excavation Inc. (summer maintenance)

- Summer 2026: \$17,200 + taxes

Feasibility Study – Recreation and Tourism Hub

Following the award of a \$20,000 grant from the Regional Partnership and Digital Transformation in Tourism Agreement (EPRTNT), the Argenteuil RCM will assist the Municipality with the feasibility and viability study for a recreational and tourism hub on the site of the Chutes de la Rouge campground.

The council authorized the mandate to conduct this study to be awarded to the organization Versant Est, for an amount of \$45,000 plus taxes.

Human Resources

Council approved the hiring of two students for the summer of 2026 (public works and maintenance) as part of the financial assistance received from the Canada Summer Jobs program.

It also authorized the hiring of one permanent driver and one temporary driver to support municipal operations.

REGULATIONS

The council adopted two regulations:

- Regulation on the compensation of municipal elected officials;
- Regulation amending the urban plan, in particular to better regulate certain types of housing.

Two draft by-laws were tabled concerning:

- Municipal service fees
- The conduct of council meetings

PUBLIC WORKS AND TECHNICAL SERVICES

The council authorized the awarding of the following contracts:

- Topographic surveys on Principale Street in preparation for future work to Nivelax, in the amount of \$6,200 plus tax;
- Blasting work as part of the projects on Kilmar and Lac Commandant Roads to Blastforce, in the amount of \$34,200 plus tax.

URBAN PLANNING AND ENVIRONMENT

Submission of an Application – CPTAQ

The council approved the submission of an application to the Commission for the Protection of Agricultural Land in Quebec (CPTAQ) regarding lots 6 096 266 and 6 096 279, located in agricultural zone AF-03, to temporarily allow for backfilling, screening, and soil management activities, given that the site has already been disturbed by previous work, that the project provides for the restoration of the land for agricultural or forestry purposes, and that it does not have a negative impact on surrounding agricultural activities or the environment.

New Road and Change of Street Addresses – Concession Boyd Area

Council approved the reorganization of street addresses in the Concession Boyd area to improve safety and facilitate emergency response.

PIIA Application – Donald Campbell Street

Council approved the Site Planning and Architectural Integration Program (PIIA) for the construction of a single-family home on Donald Campbell Street (Pointe au Chêne sector).

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Improvements to facilities shared with the Township of Harrington – financial assistance

The municipal council has agreed to provide financial support for a project to improve the Centre communautaire de l'Âge d'or, located in Harrington, which is open to residents of
