



SUMMARY OF THE COUNCIL MEETING OF JUNE 9, 2026

FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION

Janitorial Services Contract

Council awarded a janitorial services contract for municipal buildings to Ms. Carolle Guertin for the period from July 1, 2026, to June 30, 2027, for a maximum amount of \$31,340 + taxes.

Workplace Civility Training

A contract was awarded to the firm EVOCrh to deliver a workshop aimed at promoting a healthy and respectful work environment, for a total of \$2,800 + taxes.

School Space Planning

Council approved the school space planning of the Centre de services scolaire de la Rivière-du-Nord for the purposes of the Plan d'infrastructures du Québec 2027–2037.

HUMAN RESOURCES

Hiring

Council authorized the hiring of Mr. Kevin Lecours as a permanent Class 1 driver.

FINANCE

2025 Financial Report

Council accepted the tabling of the consolidated financial report for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2025, showing a surplus of \$1,666,328.

PUBLIC WORKS AND TECHNICAL SERVICES

Several decisions were made:

- Authorization of cost overruns for projects related to Kilmar Road:
 - Work supervision: \$13,515 + taxes (HKR)
 - Plans and specifications: \$4,870 + taxes (Parallèle 54)
- Authorization for the ministère des Transports du Québec (MTQ) to use certain municipal roads for temporary detours
- Awarding of contracts for:

- Purchase of sports equipment for Paul-Bougie Park (\$20,232.70 + taxes) – Sport Direct
- Acquisition of an excavator (\$313,590 + taxes) – Longus Équipement Inc.
- Purchase of a hydraulic hammer (\$37,590 + taxes) – United Rentals
- Roadside mowing work (\$9,831.57) – Excavation Heatlie

URBAN PLANNING AND ENVIRONMENT

Toponymy

Council adopted a toponymic naming policy and created a committee responsible for reviewing requests and making recommendations regarding place names.

Urban Planning Projects (PIIA)

Two projects were approved:

- Roof replacement at 1860 Route 148
- Construction of a single-family dwelling at 10 Paquette Street

PUBLIC SAFETY

- Council approved the awarding of a fire prevention services contract (\$21,600) to Action PMU for inspections, drills, intervention plans, and reporting
- The 2025–2035 fire safety coverage plan of the MRC d’Argenteuil was approved

REGULATIONS

Council adopted several by-laws:

- By-law 2026-05-103 on the internal management of council meetings
- By-law 2026-04-101 on the publication of municipal public notices
- By-law 2026-05-200 on municipal service fees

Notices of Motion and Tabling

Several draft by-laws were introduced:

- By-law 2026-06-120 establishing a code of ethics for municipal employees
- By-law 2026-05-605 concerning speed limits on certain municipal roads
- By-law 2026-06-403 concerning access to the Calumet boat launch
- By-law 2026-06-703 on the operation of the toponymy committee
- By-law 2026-06-602 on standards for the construction, rehabilitation, and municipalization of streets

CORRESPONDENCE AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Regional Coalition – Highway 50

The Municipality joined a regional coalition advocating for improved safety on Highway 50 and increased transportation infrastructure funding in the Laurentides region. Measures requested include the installation of guardrails, reduced speed limits, and the installation of a suicide prevention barrier on the bridge over the Rouge River within GSLR territory.
