

SUMMARY OF THE COUNCIL MEETING OF AUGUST 11, 2026

Municipality of Grenville-sur-la-Rouge

The summary below has no legal value. In the event of any contradiction between this information and the current minutes, the latter shall prevail.

Finance and Administration

Human Resources

Council approved the hiring of Mr. Stéphane Langlois as Accounting Technician, effective August 31, 2026.

Council also authorized the hiring of Ms. Elie Fortin as a Class A Driver in the Public Works Department, subject to the required pre-employment verifications and examinations.

Pay Equity

Council authorized the payment of salary adjustments resulting from the pay equity exercise conducted as of April 1, 2021.

Administration

The Municipality has entered into a new lease agreement for its main photocopier. The 60-month contract was awarded to Bureau Tech 2000 at a monthly cost of \$159.50, plus applicable taxes.

Public Works

Financial Assistance Applications

Council authorized the submission of two applications under the Local Road Assistance Program (PAVL) for:

- improvements on Kilmar Road and Rivière-Rouge Road;
- the replacement of a culvert and the rehabilitation of a section of Avoca Road.

Railway Crossing Improvements

An agreement was authorized with Quebec Gatineau Railway to allow the rehabilitation of roadway approaches at the Ménard Street and Paquette Street railway crossings.

Culvert Purchase

Following a request for quotations from three suppliers, the contract was awarded to Albert Viau, the lowest bidder, for:

- the purchase of culverts for work on de la Berge Street: \$16,073.37;
- the purchase of culverts for the Municipality's inventory: \$24,042.32.

Planning and Environment

Minor Derogation

Council granted a minor derogation for 75 Hudson Road, allowing the construction of a residence at a setback of 6.26 metres from the front lot line, whereas the zoning by-law normally requires a minimum setback of 8 metres.

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PIIA – 12 Bay View Street

Council approved a proposal to replace the exterior siding of a residence located at 12 Bay View Street, within the Highway 148 Scenic Route sector. The project involves the installation of khaki-coloured vinyl siding. Following a review by the Planning Advisory Committee (PAC), Council determined that the work meets the architectural integration objectives for the area and is compatible with the existing building.

By-laws

Council adopted a draft by-law regarding conditional uses, which will provide a framework for certain specific land uses, including some forms of accommodation and accessory residential units, based on established evaluation criteria.

Council also adopted the second draft by-law governing detached accessory dwelling units (DADUs) within the Municipality.

Finally, the new Contract Management By-law was adopted.

Support for Community Organizations

Council granted the Réseau de dépannage alimentaire de l'ouest d'Argenteuil :

- a financial contribution of \$8,000 to support its activities;
- a sponsorship of \$500 to mark the organization's 30th anniversary.
